What motivated you to apply for a new gTLD?

We wanted to create a digital identity for the city and citizens of Berlin. Creating and providing a local digital identity, delivering a trusted namespace, and eliminating the scarcity of good names are among some of the reasons we invented the idea of cityTLDs.

How are you using the gTLD?

We provide a digital namespace that is open to all locals. On a technical level, we operate the DNS registry database and monitor the namespace for abuse. We use the name dot.berlin, where we provide general information about our cityTLD. Furthermore, we support the local community including charitable organizations with cost-free domain names, and the technical community.

What were some of the considerations you made before applying?

There were many areas to consider – a suitable and fair structure of the namespace, the business model, registration policies, the skills of our team, and the technical infrastructure that would be required.
